

CAPSTONE SUBMISSION PROCESS

Your Capstone project submission on **May 15, 2020** (for teacher assessment prior to the presentation May 25-29) must include:

Experimental Research Paper Capstone:

- A completed document and a Works Cited page that includes all referenced information. You must also include a 50-word abstract/precis (summary) at the beginning of your paper that is a short summary of what your paper includes.

Entrepreneur Capstone:

- An explanation of the concept behind the business, copies of any research methods used, and data collected, a copy of your business plan, and any designs created (store layouts, logo/brands, concept ideas, etc.) that were created. Please include a 50-word explanation about the motivation behind your entrepreneurial idea.

Event Capstone:

- Everything you would need to host the event. I understand the hosting of the event is not possible at this time, but students planning an event need submit a package that includes all of the necessary advertising and planning documents. Someone should be able to take the package and host the event with no further prep. Please include a 50-word explanation about the motivation behind your capstone.

Project Capstone:

- Multiple pictures, from different angles, of the completed project and planning documents that were used to complete the project (diagrams, blueprints/plans, budget for materials, list of materials used, etc.). Please include a 50-word explanation about the motivation behind your capstone.

Service Oriented Capstone:

- A description of the problem faced in the community and evidence of what you did to remedy the issue. This could include a write up, pictures, video, blog, etc. Please include a 50-word explanation about the motivation behind your capstone.

Please contact me if you find none of the above fit your Capstone strand and you are confused as to what you should be submitting for your final project.
